SPONSOR A COMMUNITY GARDEN

Our community aims to establish a sustainable and productive garden that fosters food security and community engagement. The proposed garden will cover an area of $12m \times 13m$ and accommodate eight garden beds.

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

The primary goal of this community garden is to promote food sustainability by cultivating spinach, lettuce, baby spinach, cabbage, cauliflower, dhania, to name a few. Through these crops, we aim to contribute our food security and to become self-sustainable.

PLAN/LAYOUT

The garden layout will comprise of eight garden beds optimized for planting spinach, lettuce, baby spinach, and cabbage. Each row is estimated to yield up to 60 bundles/separate plants, facilitating efficient and productive growth especially with its pipelines having adjustable drippers in it ensuring constant and enough water to suffice the plants.

BUDGET CONSIDERATIONS

An estimated budget of R38 000-00 has been allocated for this project. This includes expenses for seeds, soil, water tanks, booster pump, and pipes and fittings to ensure effective irrigation.
